1.1 Please summarise what you are seeking from us

Only 3% of refugees reach tertiary education, whilst the global average enrolment rate is 37%. Mosaik's Guidance Programme help refugees to develop the skills to explore, evaluate, and pursue tertiary education, while building 21st century skills. Mosaik is seeking £5k to update our resources so that they can be scaled to meet the significant demand for the programme.

1.2 Tell us more about your project and the impact it will have

Background

Only 3% of refugees reach tertiary education, whilst the global average enrolment rate is 37%. Refugees experience a range of positive outcomes from accessing tertiary education, including becoming leaders in their communities, building self sufficiency and supporting their families.

Since 2015, there has been an increase in the number of scholarships, online courses and training opportunities afforded to refugees - and UNHCR has set a target to increase refugee tertiary education access to 15% by 2030. Yet, young refugees are often unaware of the range of opportunities, what they entail, and struggle with the demands of applications, with reports from Mastercard Foundation and the American University of Beirut finding a need for guidance and counselling to support refugees transition from secondary to tertiary education. UNHCR has also made "reliable, transparent information on higher education opportunities to refugees" as a key part of their roadmap to achieving the 15% target.

Our Guidance Programme

Mosaik's Guidance Programme help refugees to develop the skills to explore, evaluate, and pursue tertiary education, while building 21st century skills.

The Guidance Programme consist of eight modules of digital learning materials and activities. They can be facilitated in-person, remotely or a blended setup. Our current model is to train facilitators at local community organisations who lead delivery. We also provide delivery tools (e.g. data collection) and support to facilitators for quality control.

Our vision is that all refugees transitioning from secondary to tertiary education by 2030 (500k = UNHCR's 15% target) can use the Guidance Programme to help realise their ambitions. We will do this by making the Workshops open resources for community organisations and governments, achieving efficiency at scale through codifying and automating our training and delivery support tools.

Impact so far

Our impact and outcomes data found that 97% of participants said the programme helped them pursue tertiary education; 85% had used skills from the workshop within 5 weeks; and within 6 months, 54% had applied to a tertiary opportunity, 57% of whom received an offer to study.

This project

Our vision is that all refugees transitioning from secondary to tertiary education by 2030 (500,000 = UNHCR's 15% target) can use the Guidance Programme to help realise their ambitions. To progress towards this vision, we need to adapt our resources so that they can be more easily scaled and adapted in different contexts.

In this project, we plan to update our existing Guidance Programme resources to be a set of open, modular resources, available in English and Arabic, that can be used and adapted by community organisations and international organisations. Mosaik will revise the content, the learning design, updating of the learning file assets, support materials for facilitators of the programme, translate materials into English, and amend the format of the resources to be easily accessed. online.

Mosaik currently works with refugees in Jordan, Lebanon and Turkey. Although the majority of this group is made up of Syrian refugees, our programme participants also include refugees from Iraq, Sudan, Somalia, Palestine, and Eritrea,

Mosaik's long-term strategy is to integrate the Guidance Programme resources into the programmes and curricula of international organisations and national governments where there are high concentrations of refugees. Mosaik would generate revenue from both of these entities to cover training and further updates to the programme materials. Mosaik is currently in discussions to pilot the updated version of the Guidance Programme as part of the UN Refugee Agency's education programme for 2022.

1.6 How will the project be monitored and evaluated?

Mosaik has developed a framework for monitoring the effectiveness of the Guidance Programme. We collect data at three points:

1. At the end of the Programme to measure participants' knowledge and skills acquisition
2. Five weeks after the Programme to measure if and how participants have used the skills and knowledge
3. Six months after the end of the Programme to measure participants' progress towards accessing higher education.
