1.1 Please summarise what you are seeking from us

International Christian Gospel Ministries (ICGM) seeks a grant of at least £ 5,000 purchasing materials - cloths, timber, some motor mechanic and block laying equipment - training for poverty alleviation, job creation, employment and decent livelihood, in Gulu Northern Uganda. ICGM will empower 90 young people with practical skills in tailoring, motor mechanic, carpentry, Block laying and agriculture for job creation employability, employment for decent wages and decent livelihood.

1.2 Tell us more about your project, the impact it will have on those it aims to help, and why you consider the proposed approach to be innovative

ICGM will empower young people with practical skills through vocational training for poverty alleviation, job creation, employment. Participants will come from young people who have dropped out of school for financial and other reason; young people who do not have employable skills to compete in job and employment markets; young mothers and fathers; young people who do not have permanent jobs and contracts and young people who are orphans, unemployed, victims of war, young women who are exploited especially in hospitality industry as sex slaves or work long hours but underpaid.

Training will be conducted by well qualified tutors. Participants will undergo 5-10% theory training and 90-95 practical training. Practical training will include placement and field work. Business development will be incorporated into each course. At the end of the course we aim to have 70% participants employed and and self employed with a contract at least; 15% apprentices, 8 % proceed to higher education in their field of study; 7% employable and actively seeking jobs.

ICGM also plans to introduce a driving school for income generation. Fundraising will also continue but ICGM's vision is to be self sustaining in all programmes.

Monitoring will be conducted through weekly emails and whatsapp contact, regular monthly reports and on-spot check by the Project management Committee and board of Trustees members.

Evaluation will be at the end end of course. It will be participatory involving course participants' representatives, training staff, Project chair and secretary and one or two members of the the board of trustees. An Evaluation report will be circulated to stakeholders.
