Lack of Vocational training services has the devastating potential to create a severe of economic impacts. Young people have straggled with life and they need a hand that can support them through vocational training that can equip them with constructive Knowledge and reliable Skills. It is noticed that 78% of youths in their productive years, lack direction which has contributed greatly in affecting the development and economic out-put of the country.

Regarding employment opportunity is that the existence of many school drop-outs & the demand for skilled labor market. as stated before, most vulnerable youth at all levels do not have marketable and employable skills for the existing labor market. Even if there are vacancies announced by governmental or the private sector, it is always hard to find skilled employees in most of the developmental economic sectors on the market. Not forgetting that construction sector especially in the new and technologized urbanization is highly increasing.

With the above analytical situation, Support for Tomorrow Rwanda hopes to partner with EDITH M ELLIS to improve employment opportunities and technical skills for vulnerable youths through a rapid skills development program involving carpentry training as a means to entering the intensive construction & building service labor market.

The overall objective of this project is to build and strengthen the technical skills in the vulnerable youth in line with Rwandan government scope of youth employment. Hence, the trainees shall contribute the skilled man-power demand of carpentry.

Secondly, because of the marketable skill they will have acquired, trainees shall be competent, motivated, and innovative in the work force hence, creation of employment as soon as they complete the programme.

Therefore, trainees shall play a pivotal role in reinforcing the National programmes of poverty reduction under SDGS strategic government vision 2030 as we expect to produce 20 trainees in the course of 6; hence 3 month intensive training and 3 month transitional period due to the rapid economic development as mentioned earlier will be employed within the limited time possible through a well-planned establishment of partnerships in carpentry companies. The rest will be self-employed as entrepreneurs through formation of cooperatives.
